We currently have \$35,711.95 in our activity account. We paid out \$6,000 in scholarship awards as budgeted. We deposited \$50 in February for nut sales. 9 Pin Tap Bowling made a net profit of \$4,418.90 which exceeded budgeted profit of \$4,000. The administrative account has \$14,616.39. We purchased \$200 in raffle tickets for the district convention, \$100 each for Lions and Leos. We won \$250 from the raffle this year. We purchased flowers for Ron Yokes and Judge Joe McCormack this month for \$121.60. We also spent \$60 at Sahale Ale Works toward beer at the membership recruitment event there. The Leos Club account currently has \$230.03.
