# **REPORTING SERVICE HOURS**

Lions Club International requires local Lions Clubs worldwide to report service hours. After all, the moto of Lions worldwide is "we serve."

The Grafton Lions have established a process for reporting service hours to LCI. The club secretary is assigned responsibility for reporting hours to Lions Club International. The committee chair is responsible to contacting the club Secretary to report the hours of <u>all committee members</u> that were involved in the activity.

#### WHAT HOURS SHOULD BE REPORTED?

Just about every hour spent representing the Grafton Lion should be reported. Some examples:

Hours spent assisting in the planning and running of all Lions' club fund raisers.

Hours spent assisting in the planning and running of all Lions' club service projects.

Hours spent assisting in the planning and preparation of meetings of the Grafton Lions club as well as all regional, state and other Lion meetings, Also to be reported are the hours spent attending those meetings.

Hours spent in the community representing the Grafton Lions.

#### HOW SHOULD SERVICE HOURS BE REPORTED?

Club members should prepare a list containing a description of the activity and the number of hours spent on each activity. The member reporting the hours should contact the club secretary by email, phone or mail to report hours for each activity.

Some examples are:

Attended the June 2<sup>nd</sup> Grafton Lions Meeting. 1½ hours.

Purchased and delivered to Centennial Park a supply of food for the club concession stand. 4 hours.

Set up the tables at Veterans Park for the club chicken roast. 5 hours.

Worked the concession stand at GALA during four concerts in August. 16 hours.

#### WHEN SHOULD SERVICE HOURS BE REPORTED?

Service hours should be reported as they are incurred. For recurring projects, for example, weekly GALA refreshment stand, hours can be accumulated and reported in the last few days of <u>each</u> month.
